Regulations

Prix de la route Mandarine Edition 2025 - 2026

Article 1 - Purpose of the Award

The Prix de la route Mandarine is an art prize initiated by Charlotte Aguttes-Reynier, president of the Association des Artistes d'Asie à Paris, aiming to:

- Encourage contemporary Vietnamese art creation in the field of visual arts;
- Support young artists as they begin their international artistic careers, particularly in Paris.

Article 2 - Conditions d'éligibilité

The award is open to anyone meeting the following criteria:

- Must be of Vietnamese nationality;
- Must be enrolled in an art school in Vietnam for the 2025 2026 academic year (any level of study);
- Submit an artistic project meeting the following technical constraints:

Medium: any, except liquids;

Maximum dimensions: 19 $3/4 \times 11^{3/4} \times 7^{7/8}$ in.;

Maximum weight: 10 kg;

The work must be transportable in airplane cabin.

Article 3 - Application File

The file must include the following, written in French or English:

- Competed and signed application form;
- CV:
- Artistic project presentation (1 to 2 pages);
- Portfolio (maximum 5 pages, illustrating the approach and proposed project);
- Valid certificate of enrollment for the 2025 2026 year;
- Optional supplementary documents (photos, videos, press articles, letters of recommendation, etc.).

Submission deadline for the complete application: October 27, 2025 at midnight, by email to the address: routemandarine@aap.art

Any incomplete or late application will be automatically rejected.

Article 4 - Selection

The candidate is informed that they must keep the artwork available from December 30, 2025, and that the exact date and location for submission will be communicated later.

Final deliberation and selection of the winners: targeted date is January 7, 2026, in Hanoi.

Article 5 - Winners and Grant

The jury will select two finalists. Each of the two laureates will receive:

- The transport of their artwork for an exhibition in Paris (at Aguttes, in April 2026);
- An art grant comprising:

Coverage of round-trip flight ticket Hanoi-Paris;

A grant of €1,000 to support their artistic stay in France.

The grant will be paid in two installments:

First payment: after the purchase of the plane ticket;

Second payment: upon arrival in France.

Article 6 - Programme in France

During their stay in Paris, the two laureates will benefit from a personalized cultural program, including:

- Visits to museums and contemporary exhibitions;
- Meetings with artists and art professionals.

Article 7 - Communication and Commitment

The laureates agree to:

- Be present at the award ceremony in Hanoi on January 7, 2026 (target date);
- Provide the necessary travel documents (visa, valid passport, certificate of enrollment);
- Authorize the use of their image and artwork for communications related to the prize;
- Participate actively in meetings and exchange events organized in France.

Article 8 - Acceptance of Regulation

Participation in the Prize implies full acceptance of these regulations.

Any failure to comply may lead to exclusion or suspension of the grant.
